MEMBERSHIP RATES

All memberships include Cart fees and Green fees.

Junior Memberships are for those under 18. Members must be 16+ in order to drive a golf cart.

Individual Memberships are for any one person 18 years or older.

Couple Memberships are for any two people living in the same household.

Family Memberships gives full privileges of the club to the couple and all children under 21 years of age. The membership also includes all single parents with dependent children under 21. All family membership privileges of the club cease for a child of a member when he or she reaches the age of 21. When a family member turns 21 during their family's membership, they will remain on that membership for the current year.

NOTICE

There will be absolutely no snowmobiling, sledding, or cross-country skiing on clubhouse premises. All winter sports activities are strictly prohibited. Timber Ridge Golf Club is not liable for any property damage or other casualty to golf carts while on the club premises. Timber Ridge Golf Club is not responsible for any liability arising out of accidents or otherwise to any person or property caused by the operation of golf carts. Any member or guest of a member not adhering to these rules will be asked to leave the club premises immediately.

CLUBHOUSE HOURS AND RULES

Clubhouse and Golf hours will be adjusted seasonally. Hours may differ due to weather. During inclement weather, TRGC reserves the right to close all business. Members should call the club if this condition is present. TRGC may close all business when no patrons are present or expected.

CLUBHOUSE FACILITY RENTAL

To rent space for an event at Timber Ridge Golf Club, a deposit in the amount of the room fee must be paid. No dates are held without the paid deposit. For outings and weddings, an event contract must be signed and a deposit in the amount of the room fee

must be paid. No dates are held without the signed contract and paid deposit. Violation of any of the conduct provisions contained in the application will result in termination of the rental agreement immediately; and all persons in attendance at the event will be asked to vacate the premises

In addition, all members will be given a punch card with the above courses on it. There is a 3 time golf round limit at each course. Card must be presented at check-in.

CART RULES

Registered or leased carts will be available during clubhouse hours. Keys must be signed out at check-in and turned in after completion of round. Carts may not have more than two persons in a cart at any time. Registered cart owners may not sublease, rent, or loan his cart to anyone. In the absence of the owner, only those family members who are covered by the cart owner's membership may operate the cart, provided they are also 16 years of age. You must be 16 or older to operate a golf cart.

GOLF RULES

SIGN IN

All golfers must sign in at the clubhouse before commencing play. This practice not only alerts clubhouse personnel to individuals present in the event of an emergency, but also enables the club to monitor course usage by members, guests, and greens fee players. Tee times are suggested, but not required.

CARTS

Keep carts at least 25 feet from greens. Park carts as close to the next tee as possible. Golf carts are not to be pulled across greens or sand traps, nor driven between the tees and greens.

ON THE COURSE

Please practice proper golf etiquette. Absolutely no more than 4 players in one group. Replace divots on tees and fairways. Fix all ball marks on greens (please repair your and one other). Rake footprints out of sand traps and place rake back in the sand trap. Do not approach a green when workmen are present unless you are motioned to do so. Soft spikes are required.

CHILDREN GOLFING

Note: this is a family-oriented golf course. We want families to enjoy the course together and to encourage young golfers to pursue the sport. Please follow basic course etiquette and let others play through etc. when on the course. Golfers 13 and under are free when playing golf under adult supervision. No children will be allowed on the course or on any green unless they are actually golfing.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE RULES

Absolutely no one (member or greens fee player) is allowed to bring a cooler, any beverage of any type, or food on club property. All food and beverages must be purchased from the clubhouse and the only coolers to be on club property are those belonging to TRGC with no exception. All TRCG coolers must be returned to the clubhouse upon completion of play. Any greens fee player found in violation of this rule will be asked to leave the property with no refund of fees paid..
